COURSE OVERVIEW

This course equips first responders with the critical skills and knowledge required to safely and effectively perform vehicle rescue operations. Participants will learn to assess scenes, stabilize vehicles, extricate victims, and coordinate with emergency services, ensuring compliance with South African health and safety regulations.

- Analyze vehicle construction and safety systems to determine the safest extrication approach.
- Implement coordinated rescue operations with emergency medical services and other responders.
- Evaluate post-rescue procedures including incident debriefing and equipment maintenance.
- Demonstrate compliance with relevant South African legislation and standards for vehicle rescue.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- This course is designed for firefighters, paramedics, emergency medical technicians, and other first responders who may be required to perform vehicle extrication and rescue operations in emergency settings.

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Vehicle Rescue Operations for First Responders

- Introduction to vehicle rescue: terminology, principles, and legal considerations
- Scene assessment and hazard identification (e.g., fuel leaks, airbags, electrical systems)
- Personal protective equipment (PPE) and safety protocols
- Rescue tools: hand tools, hydraulic tools, pneumatic tools, and cribbing
- Vehicle stabilization techniques: cribbing, step chocks, and airbags
- Glass management: removal and safety
- Basic extrication techniques: door removal, roof flap, and dash displacement
- Patient care during extrication: spinal immobilization and rapid removal

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **4 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 4**.
