COURSE OVERVIEW

This course equips cleaning services personnel with the knowledge and skills to safely handle, store, and dispose of chemicals used in cleaning operations. It emphasises compliance with South African health and safety regulations and promotes responsible chemical management to protect workers, clients, and the environment.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

- Apply correct procedures for handling, storing, and disposing of cleaning chemicals according to safety data sheets and organisational policies.
- Demonstrate the ability to select appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) for different chemical tasks.
- Implement emergency response actions for chemical spills, splashes, or exposure incidents.
- Evaluate chemical labels and safety data sheets to identify hazards and safe handling instructions.
- Explain the environmental impact of improper chemical disposal and apply waste management principles.
- Demonstrate compliance with relevant South African legislation and industry standards for chemical use in cleaning.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- This course is designed for cleaning staff, supervisors, and managers working in cleaning services who handle or oversee the use of chemicals.
- It is also suitable for individuals seeking to enhance their competence in chemical safety within the cleaning industry.

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Introduction to Chemical Handling and Safety Principles

- Overview of OHS Act and relevant regulations
- Classification of cleaning chemicals (acids, alkalis, solvents, disinfectants)
- Hazard communication: labels, pictograms, and SDS
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) selection and use
- Safe storage practices for cleaning chemicals
- Spill response and first aid for chemical exposure

Day 2: Safe Handling, Dilution, and Application Techniques

- Measuring and mixing: ratios, concentration, and compatibility
- Handling concentrated chemicals: pouring, decanting, and transfer
- Application methods: spraying, mopping, wiping, and foaming
- Equipment care: sprayers, dosing systems, and containers
- Waste management: disposal of unused chemicals and containers
- Risk assessment for cleaning operations

Day 3: Advanced Applications, Emergency Response, and Practical Integration

- Emergency response drills: spill containment and decontamination
- Specialised cleaning: biohazards, food areas, and electronics
- Chemical compatibility and hazards of mixing
- Auditing and reporting chemical incidents
- Practical integration: simulated cleaning scenario
- Continuous improvement in chemical safety culture

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **8 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 1**.
