- Fundamental principles of compliance, safety, and quality
- Documentation and record-keeping basics

Day 2: Application and Implementation

- Step-by-step implementation of standard procedures
- Risk assessment and hazard identification linked to the standard
- Communication protocols and reporting lines
- Common non-conformances and corrective actions
- Case studies: real-world application examples
- Monitoring and measurement techniques

Day 3: Advanced Integration and Assessment

- Integration with organisational policies and other standards
- Internal auditing techniques specific to Unit Standard 243205
- Root cause analysis and continuous improvement
- Preparing evidence for external verification
- Review of key learning points and assessment preparation
- Final assessment and feedback session
