It covers legal requirements, risk assessment, load securing, and route planning to ensure compliance with South African occupational health and safety regulations. Learners will be able to coordinate logistics and supervise loading, transport, and offloading operations.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- This course is designed for transport managers, logistics coordinators, safety officers, and supervisors responsible for the movement of MEWPs.
- It is also suitable for operators seeking to enhance their knowledge of transport management and regulatory compliance.

Day 1: Introduction to MEWP Transport Management

- Overview of MEWP types and classifications
- Relevant SAQA unit standards and legislation (OHS Act, SANS 10160)
- Roles of operators, supervisors, and transport managers
- Pre-transport inspection and documentation
- Risk assessment principles for MEWP transport
- Introduction to load securement and stability concepts
- Basic terminology and definitions

Day 2: Planning and Preparation for MEWP Transport

- Transport planning: route assessment, permits, and site access
- Pre-transport inspection checklist and defect reporting
- Vehicle selection: trailers, flatbeds, and low-loaders
- Weight distribution calculations and axle load limits
- Securement methods: chains, straps, and lashings
- Loading and unloading procedures: ramps, cranes, and forklifts
- Communication protocols during loading/unloading

Day 3: Safe Loading, Securing, and Unloading of MEWPs

- Step-by-step loading procedures for scissor lifts and boom lifts
- Securement calculations: number of tie-downs, angles, and working load limits
- Inspection of securing equipment: chains, binders, and edge protectors
- Unloading procedures and site positioning
- Emergency response: rollover, equipment failure, and spillage
- Documentation: load manifests, transport logs, and incident reports

Day 4: Advanced Transport Management and Practical Integration

- Fleet transport management: scheduling and coordination
- Route planning for oversized loads and special permits
- Auditing transport operations: checklists and corrective actions
- Case studies: MEWP transport incidents and lessons learned
- Environmental considerations: fuel spillage and waste management
- Final assessment and feedback

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION
