- Trauma-informed care and its relevance to crime prevention.
- Multi-sectoral collaboration: police, social services, NGOs.
- Practical strategies: safety planning, referral pathways, victim support.
- Case studies: successful victim empowerment in crime prevention.
- Ethical dilemmas and confidentiality in victim engagement.
- Monitoring and evaluation of victim-centred crime prevention.
