- Identifying crime hotspots and trends
- Developing evidence-based interventions
- Stakeholder engagement and information sharing
- Drafting a crime prevention strategy document
- Practical exercise: analysing a crime dataset

Day 3: Implementation, Monitoring, and Evaluation

- Implementation planning and resource allocation
- Performance indicators and measurement
- Monitoring crime trends post-implementation
- Evaluation methods: impact assessment, cost-benefit
- Reporting and presentation of results
- Strategy refinement and continuous improvement
- Final group presentation and feedback
