- Challenges and opportunities in CDM project development

Day 2: Developing and Motivating a CDM Project

- Detailed structure of the Project Design Document (PDD)
- Additionality assessment: investment, barrier, and common practice analysis
- Baseline scenario identification and emission calculations
- Project emission sources and calculation methods
- Leakage and uncertainty in emission reductions
- Monitoring plan design: parameters, frequency, and QA/QC
- Sustainable development indicators and reporting
- Stakeholder consultation and public participation requirements
