COURSE OVERVIEW

This course equips participants with the knowledge and practical skills to perform audiometric screening tests in occupational settings, in compliance with South African health and safety regulations. Learners will understand the principles of hearing conservation, operate audiometric equipment correctly, and interpret screening results to identify potential hearing loss. The course aims to reduce occupational noise-induced hearing loss through effective screening programmes.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

- Apply knowledge of the anatomy and physiology of the ear to understand the effects of noise on hearing.
- Demonstrate the correct setup, calibration, and use of audiometric screening equipment.
- Perform audiometric screening tests according to prescribed procedures and protocols.
- Interpret screening results to identify abnormal hearing thresholds and refer for further assessment.
- Implement infection control and confidentiality measures during the screening process.
- Evaluate the effectiveness of the hearing conservation programme and recommend improvements.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- This course is designed for occupational health nurses, safety officers, and any personnel responsible for conducting hearing tests in the workplace.
- It is also suitable for individuals seeking to enter the field of occupational health and safety.

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Foundations of Occupational Audiometric Screening

- Overview of SAQA Unit Standard 252126 and relevant legislation (OHSA, SANS 10083)
- Anatomy and physiology of the ear
- Types of hearing loss and occupational noise-induced hearing loss
- Hearing conservation programme components
- Audiometric screening protocols and standards
- Factors influencing test results (ambient noise, subject preparation, equipment)

Day 2: Practical Audiometric Screening and Data Management

- Audiometer calibration, checks, and maintenance
- Step-by-step screening procedure (subject positioning, instructions, masking)
- Audiogram interpretation: normal, abnormal, and referral thresholds
- Data recording, storage, and reporting
- Quality assurance and error prevention
- Practical session: simulated screening and audiogram review

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **5 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 5**.
