- Regulatory and ethical standards: SAQA unit standard 252153, industry codes.
- Components of a quality assurance system: policies, procedures, audits, and record-keeping.
- Quality control in polygraph instrumentation: calibration, maintenance, and validation.
- Pre-test, test, and post-test quality checks: standardised protocols.
- Common errors and artefacts: physiological, mechanical, and operator-induced.
- Chart analysis and quality scoring: criteria for acceptable vs. questionable data.
- Corrective and preventive actions: documentation and continuous improvement.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION
