The aim is to enhance decision-making in parole and probation processes through reliable psychophysiological detection of deception.

Day 1: Polygraph Examination for Correctional Release and Monitoring

- Introduction to polygraphy in correctional contexts
- Legal and ethical considerations (SAQA unit standard compliance)
- Physiological basis of polygraph testing
- Phases of a polygraph examination: pre-test, in-test, post-test
- Question formulation techniques (relevant, comparison, irrelevant)
- Chart interpretation and scoring methods
- Factors affecting accuracy: countermeasures, examiner bias, examinee state
- Case studies: release decisions and monitoring compliance
