### Day 1: Foundations of Adventure Based Learning Safety Management

- Introduction to adventure based learning and its safety context.
- South African legal requirements: OHS Act, SAQA unit standards, and industry guidelines.
- Risk management principles: identification, analysis, and evaluation.
- Developing a safety management plan.
- Emergency response planning: first aid, evacuation, and communication.
- Roles and responsibilities of safety personnel.
- Case studies of incidents in adventure based learning.

### Day 2: Advanced Safety Management and Practical Application

- Advanced risk assessment techniques: HIRA, JSA, and bow-tie analysis.
- Equipment safety standards and inspection protocols.
- Incident reporting and investigation procedures.
- Safety audits and continuous improvement.
- Group dynamics and safety communication.
- Practical scenario-based exercises.
- Review of safety management plans.
- Assessment of learner competence.

## ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **5 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 5**.
