This course equips freight forwarding professionals with the knowledge and skills to implement security measures that protect goods, assets, and personnel throughout the supply chain. Participants will learn to identify security risks, apply relevant legislation, and develop contingency plans to ensure business continuity.

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Foundations of Freight Forwarding Security

- Overview of SAQA and relevant legislation (e.g., Customs and Excise Act, ISO 28000).
- Security threats: theft, terrorism, smuggling, and cyber risks.
- Supply chain security concepts and best practices.
- Access control measures and personnel vetting.
- Incident reporting and documentation requirements.
- Role of security in customer trust and compliance.

Day 2: Security Procedures and Risk Mitigation

- Risk assessment frameworks (e.g., TAPA, AEO).
- Cargo security procedures: sealing, tracking, and verification.
- Document security: bill of lading, packing lists, and customs declarations.
- Cybersecurity basics for freight forwarding systems.
- Physical security: warehouse and vehicle security measures.
- Emergency response planning and drills.

Day 3: Integration and Compliance in Freight Security

- Security management systems (SMS) and continuous improvement.
- Auditing techniques: internal and external security audits.
- Incident management: investigation, corrective actions, and reporting.
- Compliance with international security standards (e.g., WCO SAFE Framework).
- Case studies: security breaches and lessons learned.
- Developing a security culture within the organisation.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **6 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 4**.
