- Rules of origin and preferential tariff treatment
- Trade compliance: sanctions, export controls, and anti-dumping
- Risk management in international trade: currency, political, logistics
- Digitalisation of trade: electronic documentation and platforms
- Case studies: trade disputes and resolution mechanisms
- Developing an import/export plan: step-by-step guide
- Future trends: sustainability, digital trade, and regional integration
