COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Fundamentals of Freight Preparation for Transport Operations

- Overview of freight preparation and its role in logistics
- Types of freight: general, hazardous, perishable, and oversized
- Safety regulations and compliance standards (e.g., OHS Act, SANS codes)
- Freight handling equipment and personal protective equipment (PPE)
- Principles of load securing: weight distribution, lashing, and blocking
- Documentation: waybills, packing lists, and dangerous goods declarations
- Risk assessment and mitigation in freight preparation
- Practical demonstration of freight preparation procedures
