WHO SHOULD ATTEND

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Foundations of Occupational Health and Safety in Transport

- Overview of OHS legislation (OHSA, NEMAA, SANS 3000 series)
- Key hazards in transport: moving vehicles, loading/unloading, hazardous materials
- Employer and employee duties
- Risk assessment process: identification, evaluation, control
- Safety policies, procedures, and documentation
- Incident reporting and investigation basics

Day 2: Risk Management and Safety Systems

- Hazard identification tools (checklists, job safety analysis)
- Hierarchy of controls: elimination, substitution, engineering, administration, PPE
- Safety management systems (ISO 45001, OHSAS 18001)
- Emergency response planning: spills, accidents, fires
- PPE selection, use, and maintenance in transport
- Health surveillance and fitness for duty

Day 3: Practical Application and Integration

- Simulated workplace risk assessment exercise
- Hands-on PPE inspection and donning/doffing
- Vehicle pre-trip safety inspection checklist
- Case study analysis: root cause and corrective actions
- Developing an OHS plan: policy, procedures, training
- Review of unit standard requirements and assessment preparation

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **6 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 2**.
