- Regulatory bodies and standards (ISO, IMO, IATA, SANS)
- Safety and security considerations in equipment identification

Day 2: Identification, Documentation, and Practical Application

- Equipment identification systems: container numbers, VIN, IMO numbers
- Documentation: Bill of Lading, Air Waybill, CMR consignment note
- Infrastructure assessment: port capacity, rail gauge, airport runway length
- Specialised equipment: reefers, tank containers, flat racks
- Maintenance and inspection protocols for transport equipment
- Case studies: selecting equipment for cross-border shipments
- Emerging trends: smart containers, digital tracking, green infrastructure
