- Monitor wildlife fences regularly to identify damage, wear, or breaches.
- Maintain and repair wildlife fences to restore functionality and prevent wildlife escape or intrusion.
- Apply relevant health, safety, and environmental practices during fence erection and maintenance.
- Demonstrate knowledge of wildlife behavior and fence design principles to optimize fence effectiveness.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- This course is intended for farm managers, wildlife ranch staff, conservation workers, and fence contractors involved in the installation and upkeep of wildlife fences.

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Erect, Monitor and Maintain Wildlife Fences

- Introduction to wildlife fences: types, materials, and applications
- Site assessment and planning: layout, terrain, and vegetation
- Legal and environmental considerations: permits, protected species
- Fence erection procedures: post installation, wire tensioning, gate fitting
- Monitoring techniques: inspection schedules, fault detection
- Maintenance practices: repair of breaks, vegetation control, tension adjustment
- Safety protocols: personal protective equipment, tool handling
- Record keeping and reporting

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION
