COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Foundations of Cultural Heritage Resources Management

- Overview of the National Heritage Resources Act (Act 25 of 1999)
- Categories of heritage resources: tangible, intangible, and living heritage
- Heritage impact assessments and their regulatory requirements
- Site documentation: mapping, photography, and record-keeping
- Stakeholder identification and community consultation principles
- Ethics and professional conduct in heritage work
- Introduction to risk assessment for heritage sites

Day 2: Field Implementation and Practical Application

- Field survey methods: transects, grid systems, and random sampling
- Use of GPS and GIS in heritage resource mapping
- Completing SAHRA-recommended site recording forms
- Impact assessment matrix: significance, severity, and mitigation
- Writing heritage management recommendations
- Case studies of heritage management in development projects
- Integration of community input into management plans

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION
