COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Introduction to Cultural Heritage Resource Management

- What are cultural heritage resources? Definition and scope
- Legal framework: National Heritage Resources Act (Act 25 of 1999) and other relevant legislation
- Types of heritage resources: tangible and intangible, archaeological, palaeontological, built environment, living heritage
- Heritage significance assessment criteria
- Heritage impact assessments: purpose and process
- Stakeholders in heritage management: SAHRA, PHRA, communities, developers
- Ethical considerations in heritage field management

Day 2: Field Techniques and Practical Application

- Field survey techniques: transects, grid systems, GPS mapping
- Documentation methods: photography, sketches, site recording forms
- Condition assessment: deterioration factors and monitoring
- Mitigation measures: preservation, conservation, relocation, salvage
- Management planning: integrating heritage into development projects
- Reporting and communication of findings
- Case studies of heritage field management in South Africa
