COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Foundations of Conservation Compliance Enforcement

- Compliance enforcement hierarchy: national, provincial, local authorities.
- Types of violations: poaching, illegal harvesting, habitat destruction, pollution.
- Environmental impact assessment and significance.
- Monitoring techniques: patrols, surveillance, data collection.
- Reporting procedures and documentation requirements.
- Introduction to evidence gathering and chain of custody.
- Case studies: successful enforcement actions.

Day 2: Advanced Enforcement Procedures and Practical Application

- Inspection protocols: planning, execution, and follow-up.
- Evidence types: physical, documentary, digital.
- Interviewing suspects and witnesses.
- Report writing: structure, content, admissibility.
- Court preparation: testimony, exhibits, cross-examination.
- Conflict resolution and community liaison.
- Ethics and professionalism in enforcement.
- Integrating technology: GIS, drones, camera traps.
