COURSE OVERVIEW

This course equips learners with the knowledge and skills to manage crime intelligence practices effectively within a South African context. It focuses on the collection, analysis, and dissemination of crime intelligence to support decision-making and operational planning. Learners will develop the ability to apply ethical and legal principles while managing intelligence processes.

- Apply the principles of crime intelligence management to enhance operational effectiveness.
- Analyze crime intelligence data using appropriate techniques to identify patterns and trends.

- Design intelligence reports that support strategic and tactical decision-making.
- Implement quality control measures to ensure the reliability and validity of intelligence products.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- This course is designed for intelligence officers, crime analysts, and managers within law enforcement, security agencies, and private security firms who are responsible for crime intelligence operations.

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Foundations of Crime Intelligence Management

- Legal and ethical considerations: SAQA unit standard 253985, POPIA, and SAPS directives.
- Intelligence concepts: data, information, intelligence, and knowledge hierarchy.
- The intelligence cycle: planning, collection, collation, analysis, dissemination, and feedback.
- Sources of crime intelligence: open-source, human intelligence (HUMINT), technical intelligence (TECHINT).
- Collection methods: surveillance, informants, community policing forums, and digital forensics.
- Classification of intelligence: strategic, operational, and tactical.
- Introduction to analytical tools: link analysis, crime mapping, and pattern recognition.
- Case studies: successful intelligence-led operations in South Africa.

Day 2: Advanced Analysis and Operational Application

- Advanced analytical methods: link analysis, telephone record analysis, and financial intelligence.
- Crime pattern analysis: hotspot identification, series linking, and trend analysis.
- Informant management: recruitment, handling, and security protocols.
- Intelligence report writing: structure, language, and dissemination protocols.
- Briefing techniques: oral and written briefings for commanders and field units.
- Risk assessment and counter-intelligence: protecting sources and operations.
- Evaluation of intelligence: accuracy, reliability, and timeliness.
- Integration with community policing and crime prevention strategies.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **5 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 5**.
