- Monitoring and evaluation frameworks.

Day 2: Advanced Implementation and Evaluation

- Leadership styles and group dynamics in recreation settings.
- Facilitation techniques for inclusive participation.
- Real-time problem-solving and conflict resolution.
- Data collection methods for programme evaluation.
- Analysing evaluation data and reporting findings.
- Quality assurance and continuous improvement.
- Case studies of successful recreation programmes.
- Final assessment and certification requirements.
