- Human rights obligations of police officers.
- Use of force: legal standards and proportionality.
- Arrest and detention: rights of suspects and detainees.
- Non-discrimination and equality in policing.
- Accountability mechanisms and complaint procedures.
- Case studies: human rights challenges in policing.
