- Starting and stopping procedures (including hill starts)
- Steering techniques and maintaining lane discipline
- Turning at intersections (controlled and uncontrolled)
- Roundabout procedures
- Lane changing and merging
- Reversing and parking (parallel, angle, bay)
- Overtaking and being overtaken
- Emergency stops and evasive actions

Day 3: Practical Driving Test Preparation and Mock Assessment

- Review of Day 1 and Day 2 key points
- Common mistakes and test pitfalls
- Mock driving test under timed conditions
- Debrief and feedback on performance
- Tips for managing test anxiety
- Final Q&A; session
