- National Road Traffic Act (Act 93 of 1996).
- Provincial road traffic legislation.

- Key enforcement agencies (SAPS, Metro Police, RTMC).
- Officer powers and duties.
- Ethical considerations in enforcement.

Day 2: Traffic Offences and Penalties

- Types of traffic offences (speeding, drunk driving, unlicensed vehicles).
- Penalty schedules and fine amounts.
- AARTO Act (Act 46 of 1998).
- Demerit points and licence suspension.
- Issuing of written notices and summonses.
- Court procedures for traffic offences.
- Electronic enforcement (speed cameras, e-tolls).

Day 3: Vehicle and Driver Documentation

- Vehicle registration and licensing.
- Roadworthy certificates and testing.
- Driver's licence categories and endorsements.
- Professional driving permit (PrDP).
- NaTIS system overview.
- Document inspection procedures.
- Detecting forged documents.
- Penalties for document fraud.

Day 4: Traffic Stops and Enforcement Procedures

- Legal authority to stop vehicles.
- Steps for a safe traffic stop.
- Use of warning lights and signals.
- Approaching the vehicle and driver interaction.
- Field sobriety testing (FST).
- Preliminary breath testing (PBT).
- Searching vehicles and persons.
- Completing case dockets and reports.

Day 5: Accident Investigation and Scene Management

- Types of road traffic accidents.
- Initial response and scene safety.
- Traffic control and diversion.
- Evidence preservation (tyre marks, debris).
- Witness interviews and statements.
- Photographing and sketching the scene.

- Accident report forms (ARR).
- Liaison with emergency services.

Day 6: Road Traffic Law Enforcement Operations

- Types of operations (roadblocks, random stops).
- Operational planning and risk assessment.
- Deployment of personnel and equipment.
- Use of speed measurement devices.
- Weighbridge operations for overloaded vehicles.
- Drunk driving blitzes.
- Data collection and reporting.
- Post-operation debriefing.

Day 7: Integration, Review, and Assessment

- Case studies and scenario analysis.
- Mock enforcement exercises.
- Review of key legislation and procedures.
- Assessment: written test.
- Assessment: practical observation.
- Feedback and improvement plans.
- Career pathways in traffic law enforcement.
- Code of conduct and ethics.
