- Evaluate the roles and responsibilities of consignors, carriers, and drivers under current legislation.

- This course is designed for drivers, logistics personnel, safety officers, and anyone involved in the handling, loading, or transport of dangerous goods by road in South Africa.

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Dangerous Goods Legislation for Road Transport

- Overview of dangerous goods legislation: NRTA, SANS 10228, ADR principles.
- Classification of dangerous goods: classes, divisions, and compatibility.
- Packaging, marking, and labeling requirements.
- Documentation: dangerous goods declaration, transport emergency card (Tremcard).
- Vehicle requirements: placards, equipment, and inspections.
- Duties of role players: consignor, carrier, driver, and consignee.
- Loading, stowage, and segregation rules.
- Emergency procedures: spill response, fire, and first aid.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION
