Participants will learn to identify suspicious objects, implement safety protocols, and minimize risk to life and property. The training ensures compliance with South African safety regulations and enhances organisational preparedness.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Bomb Incident Response Fundamentals

- Introduction to explosives and IEDs (Improvised Explosive Devices)
- Threat assessment and risk levels
- Legal and organisational frameworks for bomb incidents
- Recognition of suspicious items and behaviours
- Initial response: reporting, evacuation, and cordon control
- Search procedures for buildings and areas
- Communication protocols and chain of command
- Handover to bomb disposal unit and post-incident procedures
