Day 1: Foundations of Slots Safe Inventory Control

- Inventory control documentation: logs, forms, and reports
- Roles: custodians, supervisors, auditors
- Basic inventory terminology: pars, floats, chip banks
- Security measures for inventory storage and handling
- Overview of inventory management systems

Day 2: Procedures and Systems for Slot Inventory Management

- Detailed inventory counting methods: physical, cycle, perpetual
- Receiving and issuing procedures: verification, recording
- Transfer and movement of inventory between machines and storage
- Using inventory management systems: data entry, reporting
- Handling discrepancies: overages, shortages, damages
- Audit trails and record keeping requirements
- Security protocols during inventory handling
- Case studies: common inventory errors and solutions

Day 3: Advanced Control, Auditing, and Practical Integration

- Internal auditing techniques for inventory control
- Data analysis: turnover rates, shrinkage, variance reports
- Loss prevention strategies: access controls, surveillance
- Best practices: standardization, training, continuous improvement
- Preparing for regulatory audits: documentation, interviews
- Integration with cage, soft count, and hard count teams
- Emerging technologies: RFID, automated tracking
- Final assessment and action planning
