COURSE OVERVIEW

This course equips naval personnel with the practical skills and theoretical knowledge required to apply and maintain security measures on a warship. Learners will understand the principles of maritime security, threat assessment, and the operation of security equipment, ensuring the vessel's safety and compliance with international standards.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

- Apply security measures to prevent unauthorized access and protect the warship's integrity.
- Demonstrate the correct operation and maintenance of security equipment such as CCTV, access control systems, and alarms.
- Analyze potential security threats and vulnerabilities specific to a warship environment.
- Evaluate the effectiveness of existing security measures and recommend improvements.
- Implement emergency response procedures in the event of a security breach.
- Maintain accurate records of security incidents and equipment maintenance logs.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- This course is designed for naval officers, security personnel, and crew members responsible for implementing and maintaining security protocols on warships.
- It is also suitable for civilian contractors working in maritime security environments.

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Foundational Security Measures and Routine Application

- Overview of maritime security threats and the security plan.
- Legal framework: SANDF policies, ISPS Code, and national legislation.
- Security zones and levels of protection.
- Access control measures: identification, search procedures, and visitor management.
- Security patrols: types, routes, and reporting procedures.
- Surveillance systems: CCTV, radar, and electronic monitoring.
- Communication protocols and incident reporting.
- Security equipment familiarisation: barriers, locks, and alarms.

Day 2: Maintenance, Response, and Practical Integration

- Maintenance schedules for locks, barriers, and electronic systems.
- Troubleshooting common security equipment issues.
- Emergency response procedures: breach containment and alarm activation.
- Security drills: scenarios, roles, and debriefing.
- Coordination with bridge, engineering, and deck departments.
- Record-keeping and documentation of security activities.
- Security equipment inventory and spares management.
- Review of case studies and lessons learned.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **5 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 4**.
