Day 1: Foundations of Asset and Facility Management

- The asset lifecycle: planning, acquisition, operation, maintenance, disposal
- Types of assets: physical, financial, human, intangible
- Facility management overview: core functions and responsibilities
- Regulatory environment: SAQA, OHS Act, PFMA, and industry standards
- Strategic alignment of asset and facility management with organisational goals

Day 2: Asset Management Planning and Lifecycle

- Asset management planning framework
- Lifecycle costing: acquisition, operation, maintenance, disposal costs
- Risk-based asset prioritisation and criticality analysis
- Asset acquisition: procurement, commissioning, and documentation
- Asset disposal: methods, legal requirements, and environmental considerations
- Key performance indicators (KPIs) for asset performance

Day 3: Facility Operations and Maintenance Management

- Facility operations planning: space management, utilities, cleaning, security
- Maintenance strategies: preventive, predictive, corrective, reliability-centred
- Work order management and maintenance scheduling
- Health, safety, and environmental (HSE) compliance in facilities
- Facility management technology: CAFM, CMMS, IoT, BIM
- Emergency preparedness and business continuity planning

Day 4: Supply Chain Management Fundamentals

- Supply chain management overview: definition, scope, and importance
- The supply chain process: plan, source, make, deliver, return
- Procurement vs. logistics vs. supply chain management
- Stakeholder management: suppliers, internal customers, regulators
- Ethical sourcing, supplier diversity, and sustainability
- Supply chain risk management and resilience

Day 5: Procurement and Inventory Management

- Procurement strategy: make-or-buy, outsourcing, strategic sourcing
- The procurement cycle: requisition, sourcing, contracting, ordering, receiving, payment
- Inventory management: EOQ, safety stock, ABC analysis, JIT
- Vendor management: selection, evaluation, relationship management
- Procurement compliance: PFMA, BBBEE, and sector-specific regulations
- Technology in procurement: e-procurement, ERP systems

Day 6: Logistics, Warehousing, and Distribution

- Logistics management: inbound, outbound, and internal logistics
- Warehousing: layout, storage systems, inventory accuracy
- Distribution: transportation modes, route planning, fleet management
- Logistics KPIs: on-time delivery, fill rate, cost per unit
- Reverse logistics: returns, recycling, disposal of assets

- Waste management in facility and supply chain operations

Day 7: Integration, Strategy, and Continuous Improvement

- Integration of asset, facility, and supply chain management
- Strategic planning: aligning resources with organisational objectives
- Continuous improvement: Lean, Six Sigma, Kaizen
- Data analytics and reporting for asset, facility, and supply chain performance
- Change management and stakeholder communication
- Course review and assessment preparation
