COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Introduction to Aviation Security and Regulatory Framework

- Overview of aviation security and its significance.
- International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) Annex 17.
- South African Civil Aviation Authority (SACAA) regulations.
- National Civil Aviation Security Programme (NCASP).
- Roles and responsibilities of airport security personnel.
- Consequences of security failures and case studies.

Day 2: Access Control and Passenger Screening

- Access control systems and identification methods.
- Restricted areas and segregation.
- Passenger screening processes: walk-through metal detectors, hand-held wands.
- Baggage screening: X-ray, explosive trace detection.
- Prohibited items and threat assessment.
- Handling of suspicious items and incidents.

Day 3: Cargo Security and Airport Perimeter Protection

- Cargo security: screening, chain of custody, secure storage.
- Known consignor and regulated agent programs.
- Airport perimeter security: fencing, lighting, surveillance.
- Patrolling and monitoring techniques.
- Intrusion detection systems.
- Response to perimeter breaches and alarms.

Day 4: Emergency Response, Threat Management, and Security Culture

- Emergency response plans: hijacking, bomb threats, unlawful interference.
- Communication and coordination with law enforcement.
- Threat assessment and risk management.
- Security culture: reporting, vigilance, and continuous improvement.
- Case studies and lessons learned.
- Course review and assessment.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **7 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 3**.
