- Picking, packing, and shipping operations
- Warehouse management systems (WMS) overview
- Safety and housekeeping in warehouses

Day 4: Logistics Technology, Risk, and Performance Management

- Logistics technology: GPS tracking, RFID, TMS, WMS
- Risk management: supply chain disruptions, theft, damage
- Performance measurement: KPIs, balanced scorecard
- Continuous improvement: Lean logistics, Six Sigma
- Reverse logistics: returns, recycling, waste management
- Green logistics and sustainability practices

- Strategic logistics planning and alignment with business goals
