- Quantitative analysis: sensitivity analysis, expected monetary value, Monte Carlo simulation
- Decision tree analysis
- Risk response strategies: avoid, transfer, mitigate, accept, exploit, enhance, share
- Contingency and fallback planning
- Cost and schedule reserves
- Updating the risk register

Day 4: Risk Monitoring, Control, and Communication

- Risk monitoring and control techniques
- Risk audits and periodic reviews
- Risk communication plan
- Risk reporting: dashboards, status reports
- Change management and risk triggers
- Lessons learned and risk database

Day 5: Integration and Practical Application

- Integrating risk management with project phases
- Case study: applying the full risk management process
- Key performance indicators for risk management
- Continuous improvement of risk management
- Assessment preparation and review
