Day 1: Foundations of Supply Chain Risk Management

- Introduction to supply chain risk management
- Types of supply chain risks
- The risk management lifecycle
- Key stakeholders and their responsibilities
- Overview of risk management frameworks (ISO 31000, COSO)

Day 2: Risk Identification and Assessment Techniques

- Risk identification tools (brainstorming, checklists, SWOT)
- Qualitative risk assessment (likelihood and impact scales)
- Quantitative methods (Monte Carlo simulation, scenario analysis)
- Risk mapping and heat maps
- Creating and maintaining a risk register
- Vulnerability mapping and criticality analysis

Day 3: Risk Mitigation Strategies and Controls

- Mitigation strategy selection
- Preventive controls (quality checks, safety stock, dual sourcing)
- Detective controls (audits, KPIs, monitoring systems)
- Supplier risk assessment and segmentation
- Contractual risk transfer (indemnities, force majeure)
- Insurance and financial hedging

Day 4: Business Continuity and Crisis Management

- Business continuity planning (BCP) fundamentals
- Disaster recovery for supply chains
- Crisis management teams and communication
- Tabletop exercises and simulation drills
- Stress testing supply chain scenarios
- Linking risk management to S&OP; and inventory planning

Day 5: Monitoring, Reporting, and Continuous Improvement

- Risk monitoring tools and dashboards
- Key risk indicators (KRIs) and thresholds
- Risk reporting frameworks and templates
- Audit and review processes
- Continuous improvement (lessons learned, feedback loops)
- Embedding risk culture in the organisation
