COURSE OVERVIEW

This course equips learners with the knowledge and skills to respond effectively to armed robbery incidents in the workplace. It covers threat assessment, personal safety techniques, communication protocols, and post-incident procedures to minimize harm and ensure compliance with South African health and safety legislation.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

- Analyze potential armed robbery scenarios and assess associated risks to personal and organizational safety.
- Apply appropriate personal safety and defensive techniques to protect oneself and others during an armed robbery.
- Implement effective communication protocols, including panic alarms and emergency notifications, during a robbery incident.
- Demonstrate correct post-incident procedures, including evidence preservation and reporting to law enforcement.
- Evaluate the effectiveness of existing security measures and recommend improvements to prevent future incidents.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- This course is designed for security officers, retail managers, bank tellers, cash handlers, and any employees who may face armed robbery risks in their work environment.

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Foundations of Armed Robbery Response

- Legal context: Criminal Procedure Act, use of force, and private security regulations
- Incident lifecycle: pre-incident, during, and post-incident phases
- Roles: first responder, backup, command, and support
- Situational awareness: observation, threat cues, and decision-making
- Communication protocols: radio procedures and codes

Day 2: Tactical Communication and Scene Management

- Tactical communication: verbal commands, hand signals, and radio discipline
- Scene safety: approach routes, cover, and concealment
- Crowd control and bystander management
- Evidence preservation: securing the scene and chain of custody
- Inter-agency coordination: protocols with SAPS and EMS

Day 3: Tactical Movement and Team Formations

- Individual movement: low crawl, high crawl, and rapid movement
- Team formations: line, wedge, and column
- Room clearing: slicing the pie, entry techniques, and corner clearing
- Use of cover: ballistic vs. non-ballistic, and angles
- Transition areas: doors, stairwells, and hallways

Day 4: Use of Force and Firearms Proficiency

- Use of force: continuum, proportionality, and post-incident reporting
- Firearms safety rules and range protocols
- Marksmanship fundamentals: stance, grip, sight alignment, trigger control
- Stress shooting: timed drills, moving targets, and decision-making
- Reloads: tactical and emergency; malfunction clearance

Day 5: Scenario-Based Integration and Assessment

- Scenario design: robbery in progress, hostage situation, and ambush
- Command and control: role of team leader, communication, and decision-making
- After-action review: structured debrief and lessons learned
- Legal and ethical considerations: use of force documentation and witness statements
- Final assessment: practical evaluation and feedback

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **10 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 5**.
