WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- This course is designed for security officers, team leaders, and supervisors working in corporate, industrial, or residential security environments who are responsible for emergency response.

Day 1: Foundations of Emergency Response and Legal Framework

- Introduction to emergency response and key terminology
- South African legislation: OHSA, SANS 10019, and relevant standards
- Roles and responsibilities of security personnel in emergencies
- Types of emergencies: fire, medical, natural disasters, active threats
- Basic risk assessment and hazard identification
- Emergency communication protocols
- Incident command system (ICS) overview
- Case study: Lessons learned from past incidents

Day 2: Emergency Planning and Preparedness

- Components of an emergency response plan
- Risk assessment methodologies for security teams
- Resource identification: equipment, personnel, and communication
- Evacuation procedures and assembly points
- Lockdown and shelter-in-place protocols
- Tabletop exercises and drill planning
- Liaising with SAPS, EMS, and fire services
- Documentation and record-keeping requirements

Day 3: Tactical Emergency Response Skills

- Basic first aid: CPR, bleeding control, shock management
- Fire extinguisher types and usage (PASS method)
- Fire suppression techniques for security teams
- Crowd management principles and techniques
- Evacuation leadership and accountability
- Active threat response: run, hide, fight principles
- Use of personal protective equipment (PPE)
- Communication during high-stress incidents

Day 4: Communication and Coordination in Emergencies

- Radio protocols and communication etiquette
- Use of two-way radios and emergency channels
- Incident command structure and roles
- Multi-agency coordination and joint operations
- Situation awareness and decision-making
- Incident documentation and report writing
- Debriefing and post-incident analysis
- Stress management and critical incident stress debriefing

Day 5: Practical Application and Assessment

- Review of key concepts and procedures
- Practical simulation: multi-hazard emergency scenario
- Role-play: incident command and team coordination
- Debrief and performance evaluation
- Corrective actions and improvement plans

- Final assessment (theory and practical)
- Course wrap-up and certification requirements
- Resources for ongoing professional development
