This course equips employees with the essential skills and knowledge to survive an armed robbery incident. Participants will learn to recognize pre-incident indicators, apply de-escalation techniques, and implement post-incident procedures to minimize harm and trauma.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

- Apply situational awareness techniques to identify potential armed robbery threats.
- Demonstrate de-escalation and compliance strategies during an armed robbery to reduce risk of violence.
- Implement post-incident protocols including reporting, evidence preservation, and trauma support.
- Analyze robbery scenarios to evaluate appropriate survival responses.
- Design personal safety plans for workplace robbery prevention and response.
- Evaluate legal and ethical considerations when dealing with armed robbery incidents.

- All employees working in high-risk retail, cash handling, or customer-facing environments, including security personnel, store managers, and frontline staff.

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Understanding the Threat and Proactive Mindset

- Criminal profiling: types of armed robbers and their tactics.
- Pre-incident indicators: surveillance, probing, and suspicious behaviour.
- Situational awareness: the OODA loop and Cooper's colour codes.
- Legal framework: use of force, rights during a robbery, and after-incident protocols.
- Stress inoculation: breathing techniques and mental rehearsal.
- Environmental assessment: identifying safe zones and escape routes.
- Case studies: analysis of real armed robbery incidents.
- Group discussion: personal experiences and lessons learned.

Day 2: Tactical Response and Practical Application

- De-escalation communication: tone, words, and body language.
- Positioning: staying low, hands visible, and avoiding sudden movements.
- Cover vs. concealment: practical examples in typical environments.
- Team coordination: signals and roles when multiple people are present.
- Post-incident actions: calling emergency services, preserving evidence, and debriefing.
- Trauma management: psychological first aid and support resources.
- Scenario-based training: simulated robbery drills with role players.
- After-action review: feedback and improvement points.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION

Delegates are assessed through exercises and a final test. A mark of **50% or above** earns an **AATICD Certificate of Completion**, issued digitally with a unique verification code. This course carries **10 NQF credits** at **NQF Level 5**.
