- Benefits of effective risk management

Day 2: Risk Identification and Assessment

- Risk identification techniques: brainstorming, checklists, SWOT analysis
- Risk assessment methodologies: qualitative vs quantitative
- Likelihood and consequence scales
- Risk matrix and risk scoring
- Creating and maintaining a risk register
- Case study: risk identification in a workplace scenario

Day 3: Risk Analysis and Evaluation

- Quantitative risk analysis: probability distributions, Monte Carlo simulation
- Risk evaluation: comparing estimated risks against criteria
- Risk appetite, tolerance, and capacity
- Cost-benefit analysis of risk treatment options
- Decision-making under uncertainty
- Workshop: analyzing a complex risk scenario

Day 4: Risk Treatment and Control

- Risk treatment options: avoid, reduce, transfer, accept
- Hierarchy of controls: elimination, substitution, engineering, administration, PPE
- Developing risk treatment plans
- Monitoring and reviewing controls
- Business continuity and disaster recovery planning
- Case study: implementing controls in an organization

Day 5: Risk Monitoring, Communication, and Integration

- Risk monitoring: key risk indicators (KRIs) and dashboards
- Risk communication strategies and reporting
- Embedding risk management in organizational processes
- Continuous improvement and maturity models
- Auditing and reviewing risk management systems
- Final assessment and course wrap-up
