- Cybersecurity for travelers: protecting devices and information.
- Practical exercise: Simulated surveillance detection and personal security planning.

Day 4: Emergency Response and Crisis Management

- Coordination with local authorities, embassies, and security providers.
- Medical emergencies: first aid, evacuation, and medical insurance.
- Security incident response: active shooter, bomb threats, kidnapping, and civil unrest.
- Evacuation procedures: shelter-in-place, assembly points, and evacuation routes.
- Post-incident management: debriefing, psychological support, and reporting.
- Practical exercise: Tabletop exercise for a crisis scenario.

Day 5: Integration, Technology, and Professional Practice

- Organizational travel security policies and compliance.
- Travel security technology: GPS tracking, mobile apps, and emergency notification systems.
- Data privacy and security in travel management.
- Measuring and evaluating travel security program effectiveness.
- Continuous improvement: lessons learned and best practices.

- Networking and resources for travel security professionals.
- Capstone project presentation: Design a comprehensive travel security plan for a high-risk destination.
