Day 1: Foundations of Integrated Management Systems

- Introduction to management systems and integration rationale
- Overview of ISO 9001 (Quality), ISO 14001 (Environmental), and ISO 45001 (Occupational Health and Safety)
- Common clauses and structure of ISO management system standards
- The PDCA cycle and risk-based thinking
- Understanding organizational context and interested parties
- Leadership, commitment, and policy development
- Documentation structure and control
- Introduction to integration strategies and benefits

Day 2: Planning and Risk Management in an IMS

- Risk management principles and methodologies (e.g., SWOT, FMEA)
- Identifying risks and opportunities in quality, environmental, and OHS contexts
- Setting integrated objectives and targets
- Planning actions and resource allocation
- Compliance obligations and legal registers
- Emergency preparedness and response planning
- Change management in planning
- Integration of planning processes for efficiency

Day 3: Support and Operational Control in an IMS

- Resource management: people, infrastructure, and work environment
- Competence, training, and awareness programs
- Communication strategies (internal and external)
- Documented information: creation, updating, and control
- Operational planning and control
- Managing outsourced processes and suppliers
- Control of monitoring and measuring resources
- Integrating operational controls for quality, environment, and safety

Day 4: Performance Evaluation and Internal Audit

- Performance monitoring and measurement techniques
- Key performance indicators (KPIs) for quality, environmental, and safety
- Internal audit program management
- Audit techniques, checklists, and reporting
- Nonconformity identification and corrective action
- Management review inputs and outputs
- Compliance evaluation methods
- Integrating performance evaluation across management systems

Day 5: Improvement and Integration Strategies

- Continual improvement: concepts and tools (e.g., Kaizen, Six Sigma)
- Incident investigation and root cause analysis
- Corrective and preventive actions (CAPA)
- Innovation and improvement opportunities
- Preparing for certification and surveillance audits

- Integrating multiple management systems into a single IMS
- Case studies of successful IMS implementation
- Developing an action plan for IMS implementation and improvement
