- Risk assessment matrix and scoring
- Hierarchy of controls
- ALARP and risk reduction principles
- Case studies of contractor incidents
- Documentation and communication of risk assessments

Day 3: HSSE Planning and Permit to Work Systems

- Structure and content of HSSE plans
- Permit types (hot work, confined space, work at height, etc.)
- PTW process and authorization
- HSSE induction and training requirements
- Emergency response planning and drills
- HSSE performance monitoring and reporting

Day 4: Contractor HSSE Auditing and Assurance

- Audit planning and preparation
- Audit techniques (interviews, observation, document review)
- Audit reporting and corrective actions
- Assurance frameworks and verification activities
- Contractor HSSE performance evaluation
- Continuous improvement and lessons learned

Day 5: Integration, Culture, and Continuous Improvement

- Integration of HSSE into procurement and contract management
- Behavioral safety and human factors
- Incident investigation techniques (root cause analysis)
- Leading and lagging indicators for continuous improvement
- HSSE management system review and maturity models
- Personal action planning and course wrap-up
