WHO SHOULD ATTEND

- This course is designed for health and safety officers, compliance managers, auditors, and consultants who are responsible for ensuring LPG installations and operations meet regulatory requirements.

COURSE OUTLINE

Day 1: Introduction to LPG and Regulatory Framework

- Overview of LPG: composition, properties, and applications.
- LPG supply chain: from import to end-user.
- South African regulatory framework: OHS Act, SANS 10087 series, and other relevant standards.
- Key regulatory bodies: DMR, NERSA, and local authorities.
- Introduction to compliance auditing: principles, types, and processes.
- Consequences of non-compliance: legal, safety, and business impacts.

Day 2: LPG Storage and Handling Compliance

- Storage requirements: bulk tanks, cylinders, and siting rules.
- Safety systems: pressure relief, gas detection, and fire protection.
- Handling procedures: filling, decanting, and transportation.
- SANS 10087-1 and -2: installation and storage standards.
- Personal protective equipment (PPE) and emergency preparedness.
- Common non-compliance issues in storage and handling.
- Developing audit checklists for storage and handling.

Day 3: Transport and Distribution Compliance

- Road transport regulations: SANS 10019 and relevant SABS codes.
- Vehicle requirements: design, equipment, and markings.
- Driver qualifications and training requirements.
- Loading and unloading procedures.
- Route planning and risk assessment.
- Documentation: delivery notes, manifests, and incident reports.
- Auditing the distribution chain: from depot to retailer.

Day 4: Retail and End-Use Compliance

- Retail site requirements: permits, signage, and safety equipment.
- Consumer education and awareness programs.
- Installation standards for residential and commercial LPG systems.
- Appliance compliance and ventilation requirements.
- Piping, fittings, and leak detection.
- Safety management systems: policies, procedures, and records.
- Auditing end-user facilities: checklist and best practices.

Day 5: Audit Planning, Reporting, and Continuous Improvement

- Audit planning: scope, criteria, and resources.
- Risk assessment and prioritization of findings.
- Conducting interviews, observations, and document review.
- Audit reporting: structure, writing, and presentation.
- Corrective action plans: developing and implementing.
- Follow-up audits and continuous improvement.
- Case studies and practical exercises.

ASSESSMENT & CERTIFICATION
